

Site tragedy 'a reminder'

Power provider Synergy says the death of a 24-year-old man at its disused South Fremantle power station is a tragic reminder of why access to the site is not permitted.

The Byford man was at the site with a female friend when he fell through a floor on Saturday night. The power station, which was decommissioned in 1985, is surrounded by fencing, locked gates and warning signs.

A Synergy spokesman said it used measures to stop entry but people had trespassed in the past. The company had sent condolences to the man's family.
